**Terms and definitions**

**Decision Rule** - rule that describes how measurement uncertainty is accounted for when stating conformity with a specified requirement

**Tolerance Limit (TL) (Specification Limit)** - specified upper or lower bound of permissible values of a property

**Acceptance Limit (AL)** - specified upper or lower bound of permissible measured quantity values

**Guard Band (w)** - interval between a tolerance limit and a corresponding acceptance limit where length,  $w = |TL - AL|$

**Expanded Measurement Uncertainty (U)** - the expanded measurement uncertainty which corresponds to a coverage probability of approximately 95% that is often equal to a coverage factor  $k = 2$ .)

**PFA** - Probability of False Accept

**PFR** - Probability of False Reject

**Binary Statement** – exists when the result is limited to two choices “pass” or “fail”.

**Non-binary Statement** – exists when multiple terms may express the result “pass”, “conditional pass”, “conditional fail” or “fail”
